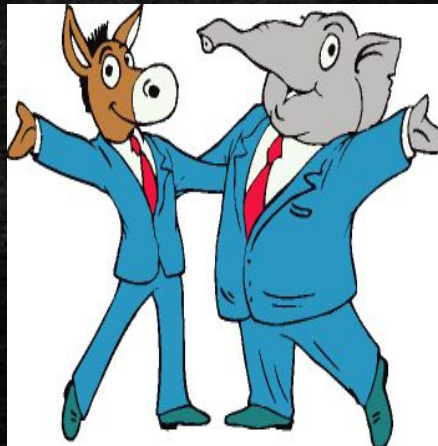


AP US Government - Opportunity to earn 1 semester college credit

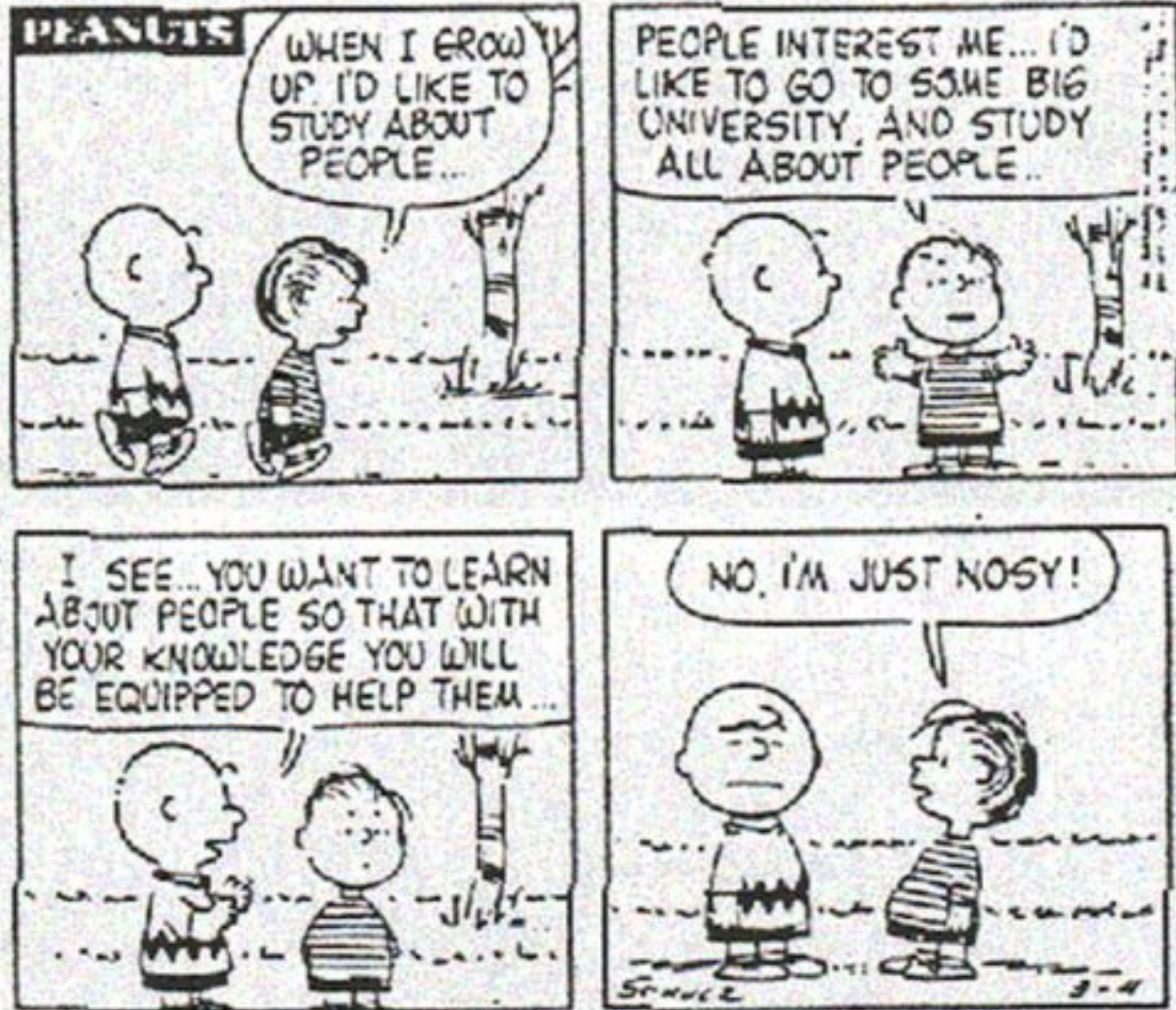

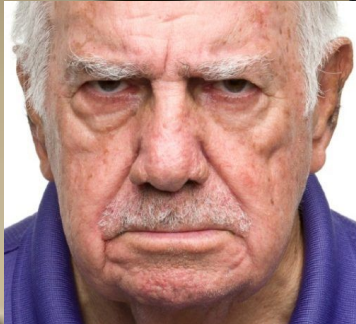
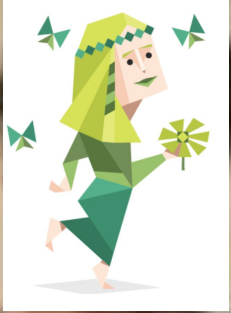
